Kashering of Kelim for Pesach (Haagola) at Yeshurun from 2.00pm – 6.00pm

Monday 26th and Tuesday 27th March

Mechiras Chometz (Selling Chometz) at Yeshurun 7.45pm - 9.30pm

Thursday 29th March

Mincha & Maariv 7.15pm
Bedikas Chametz, not before 8.15pm

Friday 30th March (Fast of the First Born)

1st Shacharis 7.15am (followed by Siyum)
2nd Shacharis 8.00am
No Chometz may be eaten after 10.22am
All Chometz to be burnt no later than 11.43am
1st Night Yomtov of Pesach commences at 7.16pm
Mincha followed by Maariv at 7.16pm
1st Seder must not begin before 8.12pm

Saturday Shabbos - Yomtov 31st March, 1st Day Pesach

Shacharis (Tal in Mussaf) 9.30am (note late start)
Mincha, followed by a shiur and Maariv 7.10pm
First day Yomtov terminates and 2nd Day commences at 8.20pm
No preparation for the second day before 8.20pm when candles must be lit.

Sunday Yomtov 1st April, 2nd Day Pesach

Shacharis 9.30am (note late start)
Mincha followed by shiur 7.20pm
Yom Tov ends and Maariv 8.22pm

Monday 2nd April Chol Hamoed (Bank Holiday)

1st Shacharis 7.30am
2nd Shacharis 8.30am
Mincha followed by Maariv 7.25pm

Tuesday 3rd – Thursday 5th April Chol Hamoed

1st Shacharis 6.40am
2nd Shacharis 8.00am
Mincha followed by Maariv 7.25pm

Thursday 5th April

Mincha followed by Maariv 7.25pm
Yomtov begins at 7.26pm

Friday 6th April 7th Day of Pesach

Shacharis 9.00am
Mincha followed by a little shiur and Maariv 7.25pm
Shabbos/Yomtov commences at 7.28pm.

Saturday 7th April the 8th day of Pesach

Shacharis 9.00am
Yizkor 10.30am approx..
Mincha 7.25pm
Maariv and Shabbos/Yomtov & Pesach end 8.32pm
